

GROUP RESERVATION POLICIES

*Reservations are **required** for groups of seven (7) or more.*

- \$22 per guest includes full wine tasting of six (6) wines, keepsake glass, private host for one hour, and designated space on our lawn next to the gazebo with views of the vineyard.
- Due to the temporary need to service our customers outside, uncovered, please make sure to bring your own chairs, blankets, etc... Please note, the vineyard and adjacent deck will still be open to the public.
 - Group reservations are allotted one (1) hour to taste. After the tasting has concluded, groups are encouraged to enjoy our outside lawn area for bottles and glasses. ***We kindly ask groups leave the vineyard's tables and chairs for our walk-in customers, so blankets and lawn chairs encouraged!***
- Under normal operations, groups may reserve the Group Tasting Room for additional hours at a rate of \$100 per hour, with the knowledge there may be an additional group in the room. This fee guarantees you a space to enjoy inside with a table and stools. This fee must be paid ahead of time, and is in addition to the tasting fee.
- Outside food is permitted in the Group Tasting Area. We kindly ask groups clean up after themselves, and understand they have the designated lawn space for one (1) hour. After that, groups are more than welcome to stay and enjoy the grounds and lawn. Sternos, grills, crockpots, or any food requiring cooking/heating is strictly prohibited.
 - NO OUTSIDE ALCOHOL (besides Stonington Vineyards' Wine) is permitted on property.
- If you are more than twenty (20) minutes late for your reservation we cannot guarantee your tasting, as it creates a domino effect for the entire day's reservations.
- If a group is unable to obtain a reservation, groups are more than welcome to set up on our spacious lawn to enjoy bottles or glasses with the use of picnic glasses. Please feel free to bring blankets or lawn chairs. Picnics are always welcome! We ask the vineyard's decks and chairs are left for walk-in customers.
 - A cash gratuity for your host is not expected, but certainly appreciated.
